The rest are too old. I am not sure if that is the recommended referential style.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. I would have loved to see the objectives of the study</li><li>2. Recommendations derived from the study to be used by authorities as they protect the lives of people.</li><li>3. There was need to cite all the references in the text as well</li></ol>
