Abstract is comprehensive</li><li>4. Subsections and structure is appropriate. Some minor changes need to be done-<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Past medical history and personal history can be included in the main clinical presentation paragraph only. No need to give separate headings.</li><li>• Table legend should be given below the table</li><li>• Highlight the abnormal findings in the investigations.</li><li>• In habits it can be mentioned in one sentence as he was a non-alcoholic and non-smoker.</li><li>• Figure legends need to be given separately for figure 3 and figure 4.</li></ul></li><li>5. Manuscript is scientifically correct.</li></ol>

If yes, that needs to be mentioned</li> <li>• Discussion would be more impactful if cases with similar findings are mentioned and compared.</li> </ul>
