<b>Optional</b> comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>(1) Better if 'platelet count' is used in stead of 'number'.</li><li>(2) Need to consider those patients on anti-platelet drugs as co-founding factor</li><li>(3) Also, need to consider those patients on anti-coagulants like warfarin, abixaban etc as they have additive effect on heparin</li><li>(4) It is important to mention the method of blood taken to do BT, CT, APTT, PT in those with permanent catheter because there is heparinised blood in the catheter.</li><li>(5) Also, need to explain the type of blood taken for doing platelet count (before hemodialysis, during hemodialysis, after dialysis, end of dialysis) and site (AVF or different site or catheter).</li></ol>
